Treasurer's Report (Barbara Binn)

Income and expenses for the previous month were reviewed and discussed. Expenses included \$1000 AF Wounded Warrior Family Adventure (money set aside from AF Ball in lieu of centerpieces), \$500 to the South East Armed Forces YMCA, \$1000 for the Veterans Day Parade, a deposit to Doolittle Hall for \$250, \$495 for award memberships, and \$119 for the website. Income was \$270 from Community Partners, \$1704 for the 4th quarter subsidy, and \$841 from Image Golf. Loss to date on the AF Ball was \$4900. Ticket prices will be discussed again before next year's Ball. \$10,000 is reserved for scholarships and the reception.
