Application Package:

- Chapter Teacher of the Year Application Form
- One page narrative of the teacher's accomplishment and achievements in support of STEM and the impact of these activities on the students.
- A letter of recommendation/support from a school official (principal or higher).
- Optional three pages of newspaper articles, other documents, and/or photos that include the teacher with students completing STEM activities (ensure students in photos have media release permission for use).
- NOTE: AFA elected chapter officers and their immediate family members (spouse/children) are not eligible
