President's Comments/Update (SMSgt Doc Apodaca)

- Wounded Airman Benefit (Casino Night) results—Financial results pending; good turnout, event went well.
 - IMAGE Golf (need a POC): need a POC; Brandi or Joe may take it;
- Quarterly membership meeting (topics, location, etc): looking for fresh ideas & way forward; think of things we haven't done in past or repeat successful events—meaningful, inclusive; brings ideas forward; many life members liked the Cold Warrior meeting and really liked it; concerned that AFA has been more for officers than enlisted. Voted to have Enlisted Heritage general membership meeting. Doc will try to contact former guest speaker; Time frame: **Thursday**, **28 March 2019**; look at Community Partners and see where we can hold it; expect 50-60 members—send out message for members to bring memorabilia to share; we will send out an email;
 - For future membership meetings, plan on last week of quarters (except Oct Dec)
 - Intro Angelo Bryant: tied up tonight; great to have on board; huge add to board;

State President's Comments (Linda Aldrich) Have been to State President training; need to be cognizant of transparency; must put numbers in minutes; we have to be careful to use our non-profit status to only use for promoting AFA; cannot have a single point of failure for Constant Contact; feedback from life members--you do a great job with AF Ball, but don't go and don't care; would like more educational things and events on where they are in life (retirement info), no "mandatory fun"

- *Quarterly Meeting*: next one at the Weisbrod aircraft museum in Pueblo; 9 March, 11:30 4:30; would like to see good AFA board representation
 - Report responsibilities: kudos for on-time reports; we'll get paid all of our funds from National;
- Project timelines: Sijan is back in good graces for state status as a non-profit; chapters need an annual calendar;
- Photographer was great at Ball and WAB; job opportunities out there—job for veteran's; listed one for Denver; there's one for \$106K per year! Colorado Cyber Job Fair coming—will get info out

Treasurer's Report (Bill Houth)

- *Monthly Report:* Checking account--\$124,534 balance but need to pay Broadmoor (\$74,000), audiovisual (\$10,000), and Center Piece bills, which have not been paid yet. There's a question on paying taxes (about \$6,000 total); since we support AF Annual Awards and other AF awards, so we should still be considered a non-taxable event; we did receive a check for \$374 from AF Ball photographer (10% of revenue); consider the costs for young members (Lt's & Capt's)—they have to attend many costly events; so we need to consider the cost of the venue—it's expensive for many; may encourage companies or individuals sponsor our military members and their spouses; we used to get 1200 folks, barely got 600 this year—need to reevaluate

- CD's are \$162,588; want to move to Money Markets; need to determine where we end up putting the \$\$\$; consider changing from 5-Star Bank to our Community Partner—Ent Credit Union; or place in USAA Bank; we need to compare between the two

- Need to know expiration dates of Community Partners through Ball sponsorship. Will run by Jeri for Bill; it shouldn't matter when they pay, just renew their membership paid at the end of the Ball

Secretary's Report (Doug Kendall) – will get the minutes out ASAP

Vice Presidents' Reports (MSgt Angelo Bryant):

VP, Membership (need VP)

VP, Community Partners (Jeri Andrews): CP members like to be highlighted in Newsletter (coming out in March); we'll make sure to welcome the new ones. Need to get the info on the AF Ball CPs so as to renew their annual memberships

VP, Aerospace Education & Scholarships (Dave Geuting): No input
