CyberPatriot: "The National Youth Cyber Education Program created by the Air Force Association to inspire K-12 students toward careers in cybersecurity or other science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM) disciplines critical to our nation's future."

StellarXplorers: "A space system design competition involving all aspects of system development and operation with a spacecraft and payload focus."

Both programs are in full swing, with competitions ongoing. CyberPatriot will again hold camps in the summer of 2021, with several locations across Colorado. Camp registration begins in the new year and we'll have a complete list of Colorado locations.

Wings Over the Rockies and Exploration of Flight

If you live in the Rocky Mountain area and are interested in interactive exhibits involving the experience of flight, flying in a light aircraft, adding aviation related materials and experiences to your students' curriculum, participating in monthly fly-ins featuring planes and pilots, or exposing your kids (or yourself!) to the wonders of flight and space, then Wings Over the Rockies and the Exploration of Flight center in Denver are for you!

In July 2018, Wings Over the Rockies opened its Exploration of Flight at one of the nation's most active general aviation airports in Centennial, Colorado to honor the importance of the aerospace frontier, celebrate aerospace as a cornerstone of American culture; and inspire the development of future aerospace leaders and the



next generation of pilots, air traffic controllers, mechanics, and other vital aviation personnel. Wings Over the Rockies is a Colorado based non-profit organization dedicated to educating and inspiring people about aviation and space endeavors of the past, present, and the future. It promotes the past at its Air and Space Museum located on the former Lowry Air Force Base, Denver. The museum hosts displays of military and general aviation aircraft, aerospace collections, and archives; and the future at the Exploration of Flight at Centennial airport.

Exploration of Flight provides a unique experience involving all dimensions of the flight. It includes the 19,000 square foot Boeing Blue Sky Aviation Gallery located on an active flight ramp at Centennial Airport that enables participants to explore interactive exhibits including a tumbling gyro chair and wind tunnel, pilot-quality flight simulators, and a virtual reality flight experience. Visitors can also listen to communications between the tower and pilots, observe ramp and flying operations, and more. All of this is available for a modest guest pass ticket ranging from \$4.00 to \$10.00 or an annual individual membership ranging from \$30.00 to \$45.00.

Exploration of Flight also is establishing the Ozmen Black Sky Space Gallery at the Centennial airport campus. The facility will use the latest exhibit and industry technology to take visitors on an incredible journey through the solar system and beyond, illuminating space exploration.

Through a partnership with the Aspen Flying Club, Wings over the Rockies offers discovery flights for visitors to the Exploration of Flight. This experience entails classroom and practical learning about instruments and controls in a single-engine general aviation trainer (such as a Cessna 182), helping the pilot perform pre-flight inspection of the aircraft, then enjoying a one-hour flight across the Front Range wearing a headset so you can listen to your pilot and air traffic control.

Additionally, Colorado educators can volunteer to become a Teacher Envoy and serve as an official Wings Over the Rockies ambassador for the student body of his or her school in order to help inspire the next generation of aviation and space professionals. Teacher Envoys are provided access to an online resource library complete with aviation and space-based lesson plans and activities that enable them to provide students with information on educational and career opportunities in aerospace activities. Teacher Envoys can deliver one-on-one and group presentations to students on the resources and attractions of the Air and Space Museum and Exploration of Flight center, distribute free-admission Museum passes to encourage student visits, participate in periodic Teacher Envoy development opportunities, and attend exclusive events. It all begins with new Teacher Envoys enjoying a free 20-minute flight in the Wings' 1930s vintage Stearman biplane or other unique aircraft.

Wings Over the Rockies also sponsors several youth programs to promote interest in air and space careers.

The Little Wings program for children ages 2-4 (with a parent or guardian) presents a monthly themed early learner program in the kids' zone at the Air and Space Museum. The program includes a reading of an aerospace children's book and a hands-on STEM activity.

Wings Explorers provides a hands-on learning experience for children ages 5-7, and includes a monthly lesson, book reading, and a take home project. Participants receive an Explorer Passport and a sticker in the passport for each activity they attend, then receive a special Junior Astronaut License at the end of the year if they attend six activities.

Wings Aerospace Pathways helps prepare participants in grade

s 6-12 for careers in aerospace and beyond through experiential learning in a real-world context at Exploration of Flight. This two-semester program enables students to find out first-hand what it takes to succeed in the aerospace industry.

Air and Space Camps at the Air and Space Museum occur during the summer for 8-13-year-olds. The camps immerse them in a week-long themed aerospace experience that include such activities as flying drones and learning about deep space travel.

In a partnership with Experimental Aircraft Association's (EAA's) Young Eagles program, Wings Over the Rockies offers free flights for kids ages 8-17. On the third Saturday of each month, youngsters can experience their first flight with a certified Colorado

pilot. Additionally, Wings Over the Rockies hopes to renew a flight training scholarship program that enables middle and high school students to work toward a glider, sport, or private pilot certificate.



While the events of 2020 have impacted some of the above activities, Wings Over the Rockies continues to conduct many of them with due regard for protective measures against coronavirus. Remembering Our Veterans




