When the COVID pandemic hit last year, Peterson AFB asked us to pause on the project, as they thought the privatized housing company might have its own solution to the issue. Unfortunately, we learned last week that their solution won't be available for five or six years. Brig Gen(s) Jim Smith, P-S Garrison Commander, and his IMA, Col Jennifer Fitch, re-approached us on this project. I encourage all the senior leaders on this email to consider supporting this project and help realize Falz's goal of taking care of his airmen and their families. \*\*\* One time donation of \$5,000- CE will hold A/C Units and schedule distribution.
