## **President's Comments/Update** (Paul Bailey)

- Election of Chapter Vice President—Bruce volunteered, Doug nominated Bruce, Linda seconded, unanimous vote
  - Paul will send Bruce a veteran's council memo; he will sign and send it in
- Paul asked if anyone was working on Chapter Teacher of the Year—Linda noted that our VP for AE, Jeff Womelsdorf, needs to be the main POC and should contact last year's TOY for suggestions. She will forward that information to Jeff.
  - My procedural issues reappointment of Chapter representative to the local Veterans Council
- Chapter officer attendance at upcoming AFA State Meeting 25 Mar 2023 in Pueblo—Linda will attend the meeting to represent Sijan
- Space Force Association (SFA) summer (26-27 July scheduled) 2023 Industry Days Chapter Representation at Peterson SFB—need someone to man the table at the Officer's Club; Darius will plan on attending and if Jennifer is in town, she will attend too
- Presentation by Chapter of JROTC AFA Cadet Medals to the five AFJROTC and one SFJROTC High Schools; Report on Mitchell HS Drill Meet;
  - Chapter representation at USAFA Best Squadron Award;
- Status of Chapter Non-Profit Tax preparation—Bill Mills, Treasurer, has sent the information to Felipe Rodriguez for preparation; it's being worked now and will be done on time.
- Memorial Day Wreath Laying ceremony at USAF Monument downtown Colorado Springs on 30 May, 11:00am; Bruce will plan on attending
- AFA National Space Working Group (SWG)—Scott is attending right after this meeting; Scott gave a summary of what's been going on with the SWG—along with the Space Senior Steering Group, SWG is part of AFA Space Caucus; want to keep the Guardian interest integrated with the Air Force and AFA; the SWG was advisory on the change to "Air & Space Forces Association"; and they're doing other things including AFA integration and collaboration with Space Force Association (SFA), and National Security Space Association (NSSA); Scott will keep us informed
- Any Chapter officers going to the Space Foundation Space Symposium? Jennifer plans to attend; Paul will give her some handouts and she can talk to folks
  - Need a Chairman for the Air & Space Ball in 2023 or 2024;
- Budget/money present and upcoming issues Mitchell HS Drill meet support—Linda said she hadn't seen any new members come out of this in the past years; Paul says there is at least one. Paul proposed \$250 and Linda seconded—no dissenting votes, so it passed. Veterans Council dues—about \$160 (10 cents per member); Paul described the benefits; Paul proposed \$160 for Council—no dissenting votes, so it passed;
- USAFA Best Squadron Award requests \$250 (30 May 23); Paul proposed and Doug seconded; motion passed



- Christmas party requested cost—want \$1,650 for our partial of the Christmas Party in December 2022. Much discussions on this; we need to do more investigation.
