MESSAGE FROM THE SIJAN CHAPTER PRESIDENT


Sijan Chapter Members, Friends, and Family~

AFA Sijan Chapter Participates in HQ AFA Space Working Group

Scott "Scooter" Gilson represents our Sijan Chapter on AFA's Space Working Group (SWG). The SWG is comprised of members from several of the AFA Chapters where USSF Guardians are located, as well as members from AFA's National Board of Directors. The SWG has provided support to AFA regarding Guardian Advocacy and engagement, as well as organizational changes to AFA to ensure Guardian representation (name change, logo).

The SWG has produced a Charter that guides their activities, currently waiting for approval at AFA National level. Additionally, the SWG has been directed to take action on three tasks:

Task 1 – Develop an outline for collaboration between AFA, Space Force Association (SFA), and the National Security Space Association (NSSA). The SWG authored a White Paper shared with leaders across all three organizations. Presently, a Memorandum has been developed expressing the overall intent of crossorganization collaboration including actionable items for each organization moving forward. The memo is with leaders of the three organizations for final approval. Once approved, it will be shared with AFA Chapters to provide support and engagement as outlined.

AFA Sijan Chapter Participates in HQ AFA Space Working Group (Con't)

Task 2 – To ensure AFA members not co-located with USSF units, or who otherwise are unaware of the USSF organization and mission, the SWG worked with the Chief of Space Operations' staff to develop a "Space 101" briefing that will provide details on the USSF in hopes of establishing a common baseline of understanding across the AFA. It is presently at the USSF Commander's Action Group for final review before being sent to USSF Public Affairs for final release. Once approved for release, it will be shared with AFA Chapters via Webinar.

Task 3 – AFA annually prepares Advocacy Papers for submission to Congressional leaders/Committees to promote USAF's most important needs. The SWG developed Advocacy Papers to provide support for the USSF and their needs. These papers are in review with AFA leadership for potential inclusion in this year's Department of the Air Force Advocacy efforts.

Another Follow-up on One of Our Scholarship Recipients

The Sijan Chapter received a follow-up report on the recent studies of Ms. Nina Florek, a recipient of the Kim Wright Scholarship. Ms. Florek, currently a college senior, proudly let the Chapter know that she has used the scholarship well as she received a 3.25 GPA in her Undergraduate studies for the Winter semester and has achieved an overall GPA of 3.264 for all of her studies. Ms. Florek first received her scholarship in 2020 when she graduated from Rampart High School, due to the generosity of Jim and Karen Wright, who established two scholarships in their daughter Kim's name. These scholarships are \$3,000 annual scholarships which each go to a deserving high school student who has at least a "B" average, plans to attend a 4-year college or university, and who plans to pursue an education degree. 

AFA Chapter and State Scholarships

Do you know a student who could use a scholarship? If so, you're in luck! There are TWO AFA scholarships available - one at the chapter level and one at the state level.

The Lance P. Sijan chapter scholarship is available to high school senior or college freshman, sophomore, or junior. The Lance P. Sijan Chapter awards scholarships annually to outstanding high school seniors who have been accepted for enrollment at a college or university, and to current outstanding college freshman, sophomore, and junior students. Scholarships are open to immediate family members (son, daughter, spouse) of active duty and retired Air and Space Force, Air Force Reserve, and Air National Guard members in Colorado Springs; AFJROTC cadets; college freshmen, sophomores, and juniors from the greater Colorado Springs area attending any college or university; Silver Wings members; and Arnold Air Society members.

The Francisco Garcia Scholarship is awarded by the Colorado State Air Force Association (CSAFA). It is awarded annually to one recipient in the State of Colorado. The applicant must be a graduating senior from a Colorado high school and intend to obtain a college degree in a STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics) related field.

Applications for both scholarships are due by 30 April 2023.
