# **OFFICER UPDATES/ACTIVITY RECAP**

## President – Caty Rozema

- Caty submitted Sijan for the National Aerospace Education award this year. For the award a chapter must do 3 things: submit a Teacher of the Year (TOY), do a JROTC event (we do multiple), plus one other STEM event. Caty chose to submit the Amateur Radio on the International Space Station (ARISS) event that Gayle participated in last April.
- Holiday Party
  - The Doubletree is the likely venue. They are a community partner (CP) and been very responsive. Caty will meet with them next week
  - Focus on bringing in younger active-duty members versus industry. We are considering a "naughty/nice" theme, offering pictures with Santa or the Grinch. Aaron's volunteered his new dog to be the Grinch's dog.
  - We can bring in games and start thinking about AFA "fun" Christmas swag
- F2 Grant: Caty will follow-up; Jennifer will look for ideas as well
- Top 3 enlisted ranks association at PSFB: Caty gave her pitch to a full house where almost none of them knew what AFA was. She handed out lots of cards. Mile High was there as well. General Murray was there and very supportive, but we've heard nothing back to date. This prompted further discussion about how to get people to respond and engaged:
  - Caty gets emails for new members and responds but they don't follow-up (0% success getting new members to respond to Caty's email)
  - Questions need to be multiple choice, not open-ended like "Here are 3 upcoming events, will you sign up to help with one of them?"
  - Use a campaign similar to the 2021 Ball where we got people to sign up at the moment we talked to them
  - New member mixers at The Hub
    - Call each new person and offer a personal invitation; maybe try to get their commander to attend as well (if they are military)
    - Decided on a May new member mixer May 9, 3:30-5:30pm (come as you are)

# Vice President – Aaron Prupas

- Attended the Space Symposium last week; it was lightly attended by active duty and Govt civilians; broadly attended by industry and international
  - Gen Saltzman and Gen Whiting spoke; Gen Saltzman highlighted his role as a force provide, his role on the Joint Staff, and his support for Guardians. Gen Whiting emphasized Golden Dome, weaponizing space domain.
- There is a stop movement for guardians. It's not in writing but need to look at whether State and National are tracking. What will happen to those who were supposed to PCS this summer and is there anything we can help support? We don't know if it affects airman right now.
- Aaron is attending National in fall and volunteers as delegate, if needed. Caty affirmed he is needed

# VP of Finance – Bruce Hall

- Bruce has checks to reimburse Caty for the storage unit and Secretary of State periodic report. Reimbursement was approved by the Officers last month.
- Forms to complete the bank account transfer from Coen to Bruce are now signed
- 15 May is tax deadline for non-profits; Bruce already called Linda to ask Felipe what he needs
- Bruce wants to switch banks statements to paperless and post where they can be viewed by Board; still getting hard copy from bank
  - Aaron suggested using the SharePoint/OneDrive AFA provides for us. Jennifer agreed and deferred detail to the Communications section of the meeting.

# Secretary – Gayle Divine (no updates)

# VP of Aerospace Education – Dave Geuting

- Scholarship Recipients
  - We had 2 applicants: 1 college and 1 from Ellicott HS (also a cyber patriot)
  - We have significant funds from IMAGE earmarked for AE; Dave recommend \$1K for each
  - Officers voted unanimously to approve a \$1000 scholarship for each applicant
  - Dave will contact the awardees to arrange presentation of their checks
  - Dave submitted the college applicant for the state Garcia Scholarship
- TOY: We received one nomination for a 7/8 grade science teacher at Lewis-Palmer MS. The submission will be awarded the Sijan TOY and has a good chance to win State; Dave submitted the nomination to State and will get with the principal at Lewis-Palmer about presenting the award.
- Pitsenbarger Awards
  - Dave recommends we cover what National won't cover from IMAGE funds



- We need to find out details of what National is covering and consider a vote of amounts and number of awards at our next meeting, if necessary
- Consider how best to spend the IMAGE funds we raise; sponsoring other STEM events and/or awards (i.e. award/scholarship at the Science and Engineering Fair, 5<sup>th</sup> grade rocket day)
- Note: The Space Force Association is participating in IMAGE this year so the split will be less

## Veterans'/Government Affairs

- There is a push to move Space Command to Huntsville again. Aaron is working with Govt entities; provided recommendations.
- Although national security is key, the decision is likely to be political and it will move.

## **Communications – Jennifer Hall**

- Jennifer requested approval for website domain renewal for 2025 due 6/5/25. It's \$17.84/yr plus additional \$10.10 for private registration which masks name/phone of POC (currently Jennifer) in public "WhoIs" database. Officers voted unanimously to approve.
- We received a sponsorship request/email from COS Hispanic Chamber for a Veteran's event they're holding this fall. All agreed it's something we can put in our newsletter as an opportunity.
- Jennifer ran across a website where veterans can create an account and request discounted tickets to sporting events. Vets only, not family members, except Gold Star. VetTix.com. This is also something that can be put in the newsletter as information for our membership.
- Facebook account.
  - After more research, Jennifer found non-profits and businesses cannot have an independent FB account, only a page which must be associated with a POC from the organization.
  - Currently, Bill Houth is the page owner. He must go to the page from his personal FB account and give Jennifer full control. Then she can remove him and will have authorization to add others with full control and/or admins. She emailed him but hasn't received a response. Bill owns a remodeling company in town so we may be able to pay him a visit there.
  - Without authorization from Bill, the page cannot be shutdown and Jennifer is the only one with admin permissions. The Admin still cannot manage followers and cannot add other admins for support, Duplicating the page would cause confusion and getting to speak with a human at FB to fix the situation is nearly impossible.
- We really need some CP feature write-ups for our newsletters. We could pull stuff from their web pages if we have a current list of our CPs. Allie has reached out and Caty will follow up with her.
- AFA Sharepoint/Onedrive: Those with official AFA addresses plus Allie and Sharla should have received one or more sharepoint email invites to "Sijan Board" site. Check it out and see if the link works. There are already folders set up for meeting minutes, TOY, and scholarships and it's easy to create others. Jennifer can provide training and/or access tips if anyone would like. Mobile access is an issue. It's much easier from a laptop/desktop.
